Duties and Responsibilities

- Abide by and promote all Club policies.
- To encourage and assist polo players of all abilities to achieve their full potential with the objective of achieving district and national standards where appropriate.
- To provide quality coaching programmes, and to lead the coaching team.
- To provide clear, progressive and accessible development pathways for polo players and coach's of all abilities.
- Lead and co-ordinate the coaching team .
- Provide advice, support, encouragement/mentor assistant coaches and helpers.
- Liaise with Team Managers for organisation and administration.
- Develop session plans.
- Assist athletes to achieve their full potential with the objective of achieving district/national/international/world class standards.
- Organise squad training.
- Structure squads based on ability, age and sex.
- Promote the development of new athletes into the sport by identified avenues and structured integration.
- Ensure water polo sessions are covered by suitable qualified personnel.

- With the help of the other relevant coaches, select teams for the various competitions.
- Liaise with Water polo Convenor.
- To sign, and agree to comply with, a Coaches Code of Conduct.
- Attend Club committee meetings and provide written/verbal reports as requested.
- Attend Water polo committee meetings.
- Attend fundraising events.
